tion to dismiss made by Roman F. Grocheski, assistant prosecuting attorney, in the suit brought against him by John Dupree who seeks to recover \$10,000 of which Dupres alleges he paid Glocheski \$7,000 to remove from the state a witness in a case against him. Glocheski argued that if the money had been paid to him to perform an illegal act this fact destroyed the validity of Dupree's case. Dupree has produced a contract in which it is provided that the money paid Glocheski should be returned if the terms of the agreement were not carried out. court also held that Glocheski never performed the illegal act for which he is alleged to have received Dupree's \$7,000 and must therefore appear and defend himself on the complaint against him. Glocheski was taken in custouy some time ago on a capias.
