## Dupree Case Is to Be Taken Up in Superior Court.

John Dupree, the aged lumberman, arrested more than a year ago charged with an offense against a little girl, is to be placed on trial in Superior court tomorrow morning. At least the case has been definitely set and the arrangements all are made. But this case has been set several times before with some complication arising at the last moment to prevent the trial. The last time Mr. Dupree was attacked with appendicitis and underwent an operation.

In this case Prosecuting Attorney Phelps is barred from appearing. When the alleged offense was committed Mr. Phelps was in law partnership with Dunham & Dunham and this firm was retained in Dupree's defense.

While Phelps had no part in the preparation of the case, which was entirely in the hands of M. L. Dunham, the fact that he was in the firm is sufficient to preclude his acting at the trial. Assistant Prosecutor Louis T. Herman will appear for the people.
