

# DUPREE GETS ANOTHER TRIAL IN SUPERIOR COURT

Because of a technicality in the wording of the law, John DuPree, charged with mistreating a young girl, will be given another trial. Judge Stuart has granted a motion for a new trial on the grounds that one of the men who sat on the jury which convicted DuPree was not a citizen of the United States. DuPree was convicted and an appeal was taken to the Supreme court, which tribunal sustained the action of the lower court. Then a motion was made for a new trial on the grounds mentioned.
